John T. Hardesty

Death Record, Montgomery Co., OH, Probate Court: 1893, page 237, line 18. Residence, 1137 W. 3rd St., Dayton. Age at death, 52 years, 5 months, 16 days. Age should be 3 months if sources are correct which have John's birth month as December 1840.

1870 Maryland Census, Baltimore Co., 17th Ward: John T. age 29, Carpenter, born in MD, Elizabeth age 28, born in Penn, Alvin age 7, Lillie M. age 4, Harry age 3; children born in Ohio.

1880 Ohio Census, Montgomery Co., Dayton, District 154, Wayne Street: John age 38, Carpenter, Elizabeth age 37, Alvin age 17, Lilly M. age 14, Harry age 11(should be 12 or 13), Cora age 9, John age 7, Bessie age 4, Eddie age 11 months.

Note: Possible parents of John T. Hardesty are William Hardesty and Elizabeth as shown in the census information below. There is a George W. listed in the 1889/1890 Dayton, Ohio Directory at the same address with John T. Hardesty and family members. Based on the 1860 Maryland Census George could be John's brother. [working with Stan Hardesty who is a descendant of William E., son of William Hardesty and Elizabeth. Stan thinks Elizabeth is Elizabeth Lyles.]

1840 Maryland, Anne Arundel Co., 1st district: William age 20 to 30, female 20 to 30, no children; John T. isn't born until Oct or Dec 1840. The ages are consistent with the William and Elizabeth in the 1850 & 1860 census of the same county.

1850 Maryland, Anne Arundel Co., 1st district: William 39, Wheelwright, Elisabeth 27 (probably should be 37 since she is listed as 46 in the next census ten years later, John T. 9, Ann 8, William E. 4, Mary M. 1

1860 Maryland, Anne Arundel Co., dis 8: Wm 49, Elizabeth 46, Ann age not readable, William 15, Mary 13, Josephine 11, George 6, James 2. There is a John Hardesty living in the next house with the family of George Wood and Caroline. John is listed as 19. John and his family appear in the 1870 Maryland census

next to the same George & Caroline Wood family in Baltimore Co. In 1870 Josephine, age 23, is listed as a Wood, but not in age order with the other Wood children.

Elizabeth Von Neida

Death Certificate notes residence of 68 Forrer Blvd, Montgomery Co., Oakwood. (Same address as son Harry Hardesty. Harry is listed as Informant on the certificate.) Undertaker is J.S. Coffman.

Place of Death: Van Buren Township, Dayton State Hospital

Alvin E. Hardesty

Alvin was employed as a bartender in Richmond, Indiana in 1893-94 as shown in the Richmond Directory; "Alvin E. Hardesty (Mamie) bartender Huntington Hotel h. over 818 Main."

Lillian M. Hardesty

Lillie (Lillian) Hardesty is listed in her father's home in Dayton city directories prior to 1892. Lillie Stanley is listed in the William's Dayton City Directory (1895-96) as widow of Ernest, res 31 N Webster, Dayton. She is not found in later city directories or in the 1900 census.

Thaddeus Waltz, a descendant of Bessie Hardesty Duerr gave the following information passed down to him by an aunt, Florence Ruth Duerr (b.1896) in which she stated: "My grandmother, Elisabeth von Nieda, was born in August of 1841. She married John Hardesty (of Baltimore, Md.), who was a Civil War veteran... stories of girlhood in Penn. and Ohio... Grandma and Grandpa had nine children; Alvin, Harry, John, Lillie, Cora, Birdie, Bessie, Edward, and James... may have gone back East to marry in Baltimore... the Hardesty's were persuaded to move to Indiana where my mother, "Bessie Belle" Hardesty was born on a farm just south of Columbus, Indiana in 1876... they moved back to Dayton about 1891... Her (Bessie) oldest brother, Alvin, worked in taverns and restaurants; Harry went to work for Grandpa (Soloman von Nieda) at the United Brethren Publishing Company; Cora married a man named Baker and lived in Columbus, Indiana; Lillie married a man named Ernest Stanley and lived in Maryland. They had a son named Ernest, both dying very soon after his birth. Cora adopted the boy; brothers John and Ed also went back East and had a upholstery business in Washington, D.C...."

Harry H. Hardesty

1900 Ohio Census (June 1, 1900): Montgomery Co.; Dayton; District 36, North Jefferson Street, house# 232: Harry age 30, Book-binder, born Aug 1869; Callie age 28, born April 1872; Elizabeth(mother of Harry), age 57, born Aug 1842 Penn, Widow, 8 children born-8 living; Edward W. (brother of Harry), Furniture Finisher, age 20, born July 1879; Ruth M. daughter, age 10, born June 1889, Russell E. son, age 8, born Aug 1891.

1910 Ohio Census: Montgomery Co.; Butler Twp, District 45, River Road; house visit# 349: Harry age 40, Bookbinder; Callie age 39, married 22 years, number of children 3, living children 3; dau. Ruth M. age 20, son Russell E. age 18, U.S. Navy; dau. Susan E. age 9.

1920 Ohio Census: Montgomery Co., Van Buren Twp., Oakwood Village, District 237, Forrer Blvd. Harry age 52, Office Manager; Type of Business, Cash Registers; Callie age 50; Susan age 19.

1930 Ohio Census: Montgomery Co., Washington Twp., Dis 182, pg 3a, April 5th.: Harry is listed with wife Lillian; Lillian first married at age 35.

Cora E. Hardesty

Cora was married to a man named Baker. There is a William S. Baker married to Cora in the 1900 Shelby County, OH census. Married 4 yrs, Cora b. Aug 1870, William b. Sept 1870, no children listed. In the 1910 census, it appears the same William Baker is in Detroit, Michigan, married a second time to Laura, married one year, no children listed.

This would put Cora dying some time between 1900 and 1910. I've not been able to find the child, Ernest

Stanley. Story is, Cora adopted her orphaned nephew. His name could have been changed to Baker.

1910 Ohio Census: Montgomery Co., District 139, image 6, Xeulia Pike., Fredrick age 34, Bessie age 34, Florence age 13, Carl age 11, Alvin age 8, Bessie age 6, Russall age 3. Married 15 yrs., 6 children, 5 living.

1920 Ohio Census: Montgomery Co., Mad River, OH, image 9: Children, Bessie, Russell, Mildred, Edith, Frederick.

Edward William Hardesty

1900 Ohio Census: Edward is living with his brother Harry and Mother Elizabeth. Montgomery Co., Dayton, District 36, Image 4.

1910 Maryland Census: Prince Georges, Dis 2, pg 48a, Edward & Ella, Esther, Edith. Married 6 yrs. 2nd marriage for Edward. Furniture store.

1920 Maryland Census: Prince Georges, Riverdale, Hyattsville Town, Dis 19, ED 101, image 16; Edward 40, born in Ohio, Furniture Store, wife Ella 33 born in Ark, daughters all born in MD, Esther T. 14, Edith M. 12, Ellen E 1.
